What is this PhotoBlogging Stuff?

If you have not heard of weblogs or "blogging" you are not alone... but you missing one of the new education technology hot topics. "Blogs" are easy to use web publishing tools that allow anyone to create chronologically organized web sites (usually narrowly labeled as "diaries") with built in search and comment features. They are template driven and usually offer a series of well designed layout displays, that can be customized by those with the skills and interest to so.

Blogs are public, and most typically present the newest content first, with links to automatically created archives organized by date and/or subject categories. Think of it is the simplest personal web publishing possible. A "blog" is both a noun (the web site itself) and a verb- the act of writing to that web site.

Blogs are typically text oriented, and may consist of very short entries or can be very long, multi-page compositions. The focus of blogs becomes much more on self-expression than exercises to meet some minimum assignment. And writers often began to look at what they "blog" on the light of what will intrigue visitors to post comments or to write more from yet another blog site. Blogs can become very dynamic, but loosely structured social environments.

A new interesting variant are weblogs that consist mostly of collections of digital images. They are communicating purely by imaery. These "photoblogs" offer a potential way for, say **art students to build portfolios**, or science students to post pictures documenting a project. Students doing lab exercises or field work could record observational data (e.g. plant growth, architecture styles, geology features) as project components. They might be useful in applications of telemedicine. Students might collect images of their service learning projects.

The new <http://mcli.cogdogblog.com/show/tcc04/photoblog/> is a good example of this. This is the phenomenon called "moblogging" or "mobile blogging." For example, during the drastic 2003 wildfires in southern California, a site appeared that

This web site is designed to foster visual creativity by making stories out of photos. It is based completely on the [Five Card Nancy game](#) devised by comics guru [Scott McCloud](#) and the [nifty web version at 741.5 Comics](#).

However, rather than using randomly chosen panels of the old Nancy comic, my version draws upon collections of photos specified by a tag in [flickr](#). You are dealt five random photos for each draw, and your task is to select one each time to add to your building set of images, that taken together as a final set of 5 - tell a story in pictures.

When you are done, you can add a title and explanation, and save the story. You can easily put a link in your resume or send to your Mom (she may print it out and tape it to the fridge, or she may criticize your creativity, your mileage and mom may vary). Plus we offer the ability to tweet your story or use an embed code to add it to your own web site.

What do stories look like? What a fantastic question you ask!

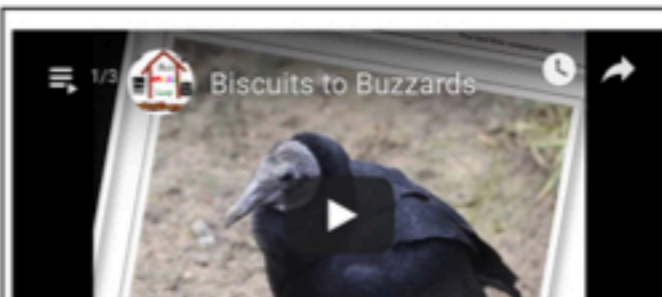

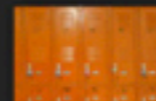
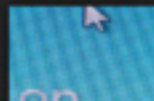

DS106: Telling Stories With Photos

Here is an exercise that is a fun way to exercise your visual interpretation skills. Below are a list of subjects we ask you to convey in photos that you must try and capture **within a 15 minute window of time**. It is less about capturing highly artistic images, but just being inventive and trying to interpret the list of subjects. Before you do this, pick a place that is likely to have a lot of variety of subjects (middle of town or campus, your basement, whatever).

This is not a test! You do not have to get them all, just try to think in interesting ways about how to interpret and capture the list. Here is what to seek in your own blitz!

1. Your first photo is of something that shows the current time! Document when you started the blitz.
2. In the next 15 minutes, try to capture as many of the following photos as you can
 - o Make an ordinary object look more interesting, almost supernatural.
 - o Take a photo that makes use of converging lines.
 - o Take a photo dominated by a single color
 - o Take a photo of something at an unusual angle
 - o Take a photo of two things that do not belong together.
 - o Take a photo that represents the idea of "openness"
 - o Take a photo that expresses a human emotion
 - o Take a photo that emphasizes mostly dark tones or mostly light ones.
 - o Make a photo that is abstract, that would make someone ask, "Is that a photograph?"
 - o Take a photo of an interesting shadow.
 - o Take a photo that represents a metaphor for complexity.
 - o Take a photo of someone else's hand (or paw)
3. Take another photo of a timepiece that shows the time you stopped. It should be fifteen minutes since step 1, right?
4. Upload your five best photos to flickr, and tag them "ds106photoblitz"

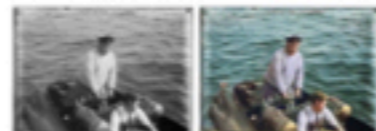

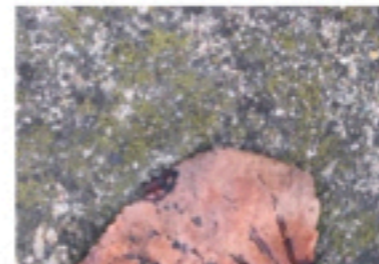

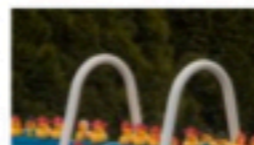
